EXECUTIVE ORDER  
(No. 11 Series of 2023)

AN ORDER ORGANIZING THE LOCAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL OF THE  
MUNICIPALITY OF BONGABONG

**WHEREAS**, Section 23, Chapter III of Republic Act 10742 or the Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act Of 2015 states that to ensure multi-sectoral youth participation in local governance, there shall be organized a Local Youth Development Councils at all levels;

**WHEREAS**, Section 24 of the same Act provide that the LYDC shall be funded by their respective Local Sanggunian;

**WHEREAS**, Section 24 (b), Rule III of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 10742 states that “to give equal opportunity for the youth, from the time of the enactment of these rules up to the deadline for registration set by the Commission and DILG, non-organized youth groups may formally organize themselves and register in accordance with paragraphs d and e of this section”;

**WHEREAS**, Section 2(i), Rule III of RA 1742 provides for the composition of the LYDC which is at least 10 but not more than 21 members;

**WHEREAS**, the National Youth Commission and the DILG had issued their respective guidelines on convening and election of members of the LYDC;

**NOW, THEREFORE I, ELEGIO A. MALALUAN, O.D.**, Municipal Mayor of Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the organization of the Local Youth Development Council of the Municipality of Bongabong.

SECTION 1. COMPOSITION

The Local Youth Development Council (LYDC) shall be composed of the following:

**SECTION 2. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

The Local Youth Development Council (LYDC) shall have the following duties and functions:

- 1. Serve as the core of the advocacy on youth participation in nation-building and youth empowerment;
- 2. Finalize the three (3) year Local Youth Development Plan that is anchored in the Philippine Youth Development Plan and the development plans of the local government units;
- 3. Monitor and evaluate the implementation of the Local Youth Development Plan.

**SECTION 3. TERM OF OFFICE OF LYDC MEMBERS**

- 1. The first set of LYDC members shall have a term of 2 years. The succeeding LYDC members shall have a term of 3 years, unless sooner removed due to dissolution of the Youth Organization/Youth Servicing Organization or voluntary vacates the position as member of the LYDC;
- 2. The term shall commence immediately after the Mandatory Training and Oath Taking which shall be held not later than 31 July 2018;
- 3. An LYDC member who during her/his term of office, shall have passed the age of thirty years shall be allowed to serve the remaining portion of the term.

**SECTION 4. REPEALING CAUSE**

All rules and regulations, executive orders, office orders, memoranda, or any part thereof, previously promulgated in conflict with or contrary to these Executive Order or any portion hereof, are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE**

If any portion or provision of this Executive Order is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other portions or provisions hereof, which are not affected thereby shall continue in full force and effect.

**SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY**

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain enforced unless revoked or amended. Let copies of this Order be furnished to all concerned for their information, guidance, and action.
