## **MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 04**

Series of 2012

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING BUSINESSMEN SECURING OR RENEWING BUSINESS PERMITS TO SUBMIT CERTIFICATE OF EMPLOYER REGISTRATION OR CLEARANCE FROM THE PAG-IBIG FUND (HOME DEVELOPMENT MUTUAL FUND) AS A PRE-REQUISITE FOR SECURING/RENEWING BUSINESS PERMITS

WHEREAS, RA No. 9679, otherwise known as the Home Development Mutual Fund Act of 2009 and its predecessor legislations mandate that all employees and employers covered by the Social Security System (SSS) or the Government Service Insurance System (GSIS) be likewise covered by the Pag-IBIG Fund;

WHEREAS, in order to insure that this mandate is complied by business establishments in Bongabong, Oriental Mindoro, there is a necessity to enact the corresponding legislation;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. MARIETA A. SELDA, unanimously seconded, be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan in Session assembled that:

Section 1. Coverage – This Ordinance shall cover owners of business establishments in the Municipality of Bongabong which are required to secure business permits for the conduct of their business or those who apply for renewal of such business permits and which under existing national laws are mandatory required to be a member employer of the Home Development Mutual Fund otherwise known as the Pag-IBIG Fund;

HERCULES A. UMALI Municipal Mayor Section 2. Requirement of Registration – All business establishments mentioned in Section 1 of this Ordinance shall, in addition to existing requirements prescribed by resolution or ordinance for the issuance or renewal of business permits, submit a CERTIFICATE OF EMPLOYER REGISTRATION or CLEARANCE from the Pag-IBIG Fund or the Home Development Mutual Fund;

Failure to submit such a requirement shall be a ground for the denial of the application for issuance or renewal of their business permits.

Section 3. Repealing Clause – resolutions or ordinances that are inconsistent with this Ordinance are deemed repealed or amended accordingly;

Section 4. Separability Clause – If for any reason any portion of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, other portions not affected thereby shall remain to be valid and effective;

Section 5. Effectivity Clause - This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
